Intervention Name	Retained Jurisdiction Hybrid Model
Place Of Birth (Country, State)	USA, Texas
Places Where It Has Been Implemented	Dallas and several other jurisdiction in Texas. There is a similar program that has been implemented in Idaho (Rider Program)
Implementation Date	2001 in Dallas. 2009 at Texas state level.
Type of alternative	Retained Jurisdiction is a post-conviction intervention. The judge sentences the offender to treatment in a prison facility followed by probation, treatment, monitoring and rehabilitation.
Adoption Method	The program was created as a result of legislation in Texas that established special facilities within prisons.
Basic Description of the alternative	
Main Objective	To prevent crime by ensuring addicts complete inpatient drug treatment and continue to remain drug free to lead a productive and sober life.
Target Population	Intended for problematic users who are drug offenders. In other jurisdictions (Idaho), this has included traffickers (small and large.)
Key Concepts	The intervention is built on residential treatment and probation principles.
Core Elements	The main features of the alternative are judicial supervision through the treatment stage (in-custody) and probation stage. Treatment is provided within the prison system.
Differential Approaches	This program is unique in that it combines treatment while incarcerated with continual support and supervision into probation. The offender is engaged and supervised throughout the entire process by a judge.
Implementation	
How it Works	Judges can sentence offenders to the Substance Abuse Felony Punishment Facility. At the facility, which is segregated from the prison population but on the prison grounds, offenders receive in-custody treatment for between six and nine months. After release, offenders are heavily monitored by the re-entry court judge and are provided with continuing treatment and rehabilitative services.
Economic resources	Not available
Sources of funding	Texas Court System and Corrections Department through the legislature.
Results	
According to several online sources, the program has "reduced crime and saved tax dollars." The report assessing the success of the program could not be located.	
Impacts on Specific Populations	No specific information on the Texas programs is available. The Idaho Rider program has a specific treatment track for offenders with mental health issues.
Enabling elements	
Because this program combines prison time with treatment and re-entry support, it was able to provide services and therapy to drug offenders in a politically conservative context.

Observations	The Rider program in Idaho is similar to the Texas program except for the fact that the judge does not retain jurisdiction when offenders move into the probation stage of their sentence.
